

2.7 Examination requirements

Step One

(Components 1 and 2 should not exceed 6 minutes.)

1. Perform from memory a song of the candidate's choice. 45 marks
2. Perform from memory a contrasting song. 45 marks
One of the songs may be a Nursery Rhyme or a Singing Game.
3. Discuss with the examiner:
 - what the songs are about;
 - the mood of each song, e.g. 'happy', 'sad', etc.10 marks

Step Two

(Components 1 and 2 should not exceed 6 minutes.)

1. Perform from memory a song from British or American musical theatre, film, animated film, or television. 45 marks
2. Perform from memory a song of contrasting mood or style. 45 marks
3. Discuss with the examiner:
 - what the songs are about;
 - the character(s) who sing(s) the songs;
 - the mood of the songs.10 marks

Grade One

(Components 1 and 2 should not exceed 10 minutes.)

1. Perform from memory a song of the candidate's choice. 45 marks
2. Perform from memory a song of contrasting mood or style. 45 marks
3. Discuss with the examiner:
 - why the songs were chosen;
 - what the songs are about;
 - the characters who sing the songs;
 - the mood of the songs (including the element of contrast between the songs).10 marks
